# Vote NO: The SAVE Act Is Voter Suppression

Let's be clear: the so-called Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Act isn't about securing our elections—it's about suppressing voters. If you vote for it, you're not defending democracy. You're helping dismantle it.

The SAVE Act is a direct assault on millions of eligible Americans. It would force voters to show documentary proof of citizenship—like a passport or birth certificate—every time they register or update their registration. These documents are costly, difficult to access, and not required in most states today. Seniors, people with disabilities, rural residents, and low-income Americans would be among the first silenced.

Married women whose names no longer match their birth certificates? Blocked. Trans and nonbinary Americans whose IDs don't align with outdated documents? Targeted. Communities of color already facing systemic barriers? Further marginalized. These aren't unintended consequences—they are the goal.

This bill would gut mail-in and online voter registration, end automatic registration efforts, and crush voter registration drives—especially in underserved communities. It would allow voter purges without notice and even threaten election workers with prison time for registering citizens who lack the exact documentation.
